FEMALE BLUES UNIFORMS

OFFICER LONG SLEEVE BLOUSE WITH TIE TAB, SKIRT

Center blue name tag on wearer's right within 1 1/2 inch above or below the first exposed button

Ribbons are optional. If worn, all ribbons and devices must be worn.

Center ribbons on wearer's left, parallel with ground. Align bottom of the ribbons with the bottom of the name tag



Optional Epoxy blue name tag may be worn

Members are highly encouraged to wear their current occupational badge

Wear only midsize or regular occupational badges, do not mix sizes

Center Chaplain, Aeronautical, Space and occupational badges 1/2 inch above ribbons (if worn) or in a comparable position on the wearer's left side if no ribbons are worn Center additional badge 1/2 inch above the first badge

NOTE: No more than two badges in this position

Center duty or miscellaneous badge on the wearer's right 1/2 inch above the nametag. The second badge will be worn 1/2 inch above the nametag and centered and spaced 1/2 inch apart from the first badge

Missile badge is worn 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

Excellence-In-Competition badge is 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

COMMAND INSIGNIA: Worn on wearer's right side. Current commanders wear insignia centered, 1/2 inch above the name tag. If authorized, graduated commanders wear insignia centered, 1/2 inch below the name tag. The Air Force Command Insignia is mandatory

Place shoulder mark insignia as close as possible to shoulder seam

Tie tab is mandatory with long sleeve tuck-in style blouse

The skirt will be no shorter than the top of the kneecap and no longer than the bottom of the kneecap when standing at attention.

The total number of badges worn will not exceed four. The commander's insignia does not count as one of the four badges.

Chaplain, aeronautical, space, cyberspace and missile operations badges are mandatory, others are optional. Women are authorized to wear the men's service cap.

The Women's Service Cap (Bucket Cap) is mandatory for Majors and above and optional for all others for wear.

Hosiery will be worn and will be plain commercial, sheer, nylon in neutral, dark brown, black or off-black, or dark blue shades that complement the uniform and the Airman's skin tone. Patterned hosiery is not authorized to be worn with any uniform.

OFFICER SHORT SLEEVE BLOUSE WITH TIE TAB, SKIRT (PRINCESS CUT)

Center blue name tag on wearer's right within 1 1/2 inch above or below the first exposed button

Optional Epoxy blue name tag may be worn

Ribbons are optional. If worn, all ribbons and devices must be worn.

Center ribbons on wearers left, parallel with ground. Align bottom of the ribbons with the bottom of the name tag

Members are highly encouraged to wear their current occupational badge

Wear only midsize or regular occupational badges, do not mix sizes.



Center Chaplain, Aeronautical, Space and occupational badges 1/2 inch above ribbons (if worn) or in a comparable position on the wearer's left side if no ribbons are worn

Center additional badge 1/2 inch above the first badge

NOTE: No more than two badges in this position

Center duty or miscellaneous badge on the wearer's right 1/2 inch above the nametag. The second badge will be worn 1/2 inch above the nametag and centered and spaced 1/2 inch apart from the first badge

Missile badge is worn 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

Excellence-In-Competition badge is 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

COMMAND INSIGNIA: Worn on wearer's right side. Current commanders wear insignia centered, 1/2 inch above the name tag. If authorized, graduated commanders wear insignia centered, 1/2 inch below the name tag. If a duty or miscellaneous badge is worn with the command insignia; current commanders wear duty badge centered, 1/2 inch above command insignia. If two duty badges are worn with command insignia; current commanders wear two duty badges 1/2 inch above the command insignia, centered and spaced 1/2 inch apart. The Air Force Command Insignia is mandatory

Place shoulder mark insignia as close as possible to shoulder seam; tie tab is optional with short sleeve princess style blouse. The skirt will be no shorter than the top of the kneecap and no longer than the bottom of the kneecap when standing at attention.

The total number of badges worn will not exceed four. The commander's insignia does not count as one of the four badges. Chaplain, aeronautical, space, cyberspace and missile operations badges are mandatory, others are optional.

Women are authorized to wear the men's service cap. The Women's Service Cap (Bucket Cap) is mandatory for Majors and above and optional for all others for wear.

Center blue name tag on wearer's right within 1 1/2 inch above or below the first exposed button

Optional Epoxy blue name tag may be worn

Ribbons are optional. If worn, all ribbons and devices must be worn

Center ribbons on wearer's left, parallel with ground. Align bottom of the ribbons with the bottom of the name tag

Members are highly encouraged to wear their current occupational badge

Wear only midsize or regular occupational badges, do not mix sizes



Center Chaplain, Aeronautical, Space and occupational badges 1/2 inch above ribbons (if worn) or in a comparable position on the wearer's left side if no ribbons are worn Center additional badge 1/2 inch above the first badge

Center duty or miscellaneous badge on the wearer's right 1/2 inch above the nametag. The second badge will be worn 1/2 inch above the nametag and centered and spaced 1/2 inch apart from the first badge

Excellence-In-Competition badge is 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

Enlisted personnel center 3 1/2 inch sleeve chevron halfway between shoulder seam and elbow when bent at 90-degree angle

Senior NCOs do not wear shoulder mark insignia

Tie tab is mandatory with long sleeve princess style blouse

The total number of badges worn will not exceed four. The commander's insignia does not count as one of the four badges.

Chaplain, aeronautical, space, cyberspace and missile operations badges are mandatory, others are optional.

Women are authorized to wear the men's service cap.

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ENLISTED LONG SLEEVE BLOUSE WITH TIE TAB, SLACKS

Center blue name tag on wearer's right within 1 1/2 inch above or below the first exposed button


Optional Epoxy blue name tag may be worn

Ribbons are optional. If worn, all ribbons and devices must be worn

Center ribbons on wearer's left, parallel with ground. Align bottom of the ribbons with the bottom of the name tag

Members are highly encouraged to wear their current occupational badge

Wear only midsize or regular occupational badges, do not mix sizes



Center Chaplain, Aeronautical, Space and occupational badges 1/2 inch above ribbons (if worn) or in a comparable position on the wearer's left side if no ribbons are worn Center additional badge 1/2 inch above the first badge

Missile badge is worn 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

Excellence-In-Competition badge is 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

Enlisted personnel center 3 1/2 inch sleeve chevron halfway between shoulder seam and elbow when bent at 90-degree angle

Senior NCOs do not wear shoulder mark insignia

Tie tab is mandatory with long sleeve princess style blouse

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Chaplain, aeronautical, space, cyberspace and missile operations badges are mandatory, others are optional.

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The Women's Service Cap (Bucket Cap) is mandatory for Majors and above and

optional for all others for wear.

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ENLISTED SHORT SLEEVE BLOUSE WITH TIE TAB, SLACKS (PRINCESS CUT)

Semi-Form Fitting Blouse. The blue blouse will be a semi-form fitting princess line

Center name tag on wearer's right within 1 1/2 inch above or below the first exposed button

Optional Epoxy blue name tag may be worn

Ribbons are optional. If worn, all ribbons and devices must be worn

Center ribbons on wearer's left, parallel with ground. Align bottom of the ribbons with the bottom of the nametag

OCCUPATIONAL BADGES (reflect Air Force specialty; e.g. Logistics, Maintenance, Civil Engineer, Public Affairs) Members are highly encouraged to wear their current occupational badge



Center Chaplain, Aeronautical, Space and occupational badges 1/2 inch above ribbons (if worn) or in a comparable position on the wearer's left side if no ribbons are worn Center additional badge 1/2 inch above the first badge

Wear only midsize or regular occupational badges, do not mix sizes

NOTE: No more than two badges in this position

DUTY OR MISCELLANEOUS BADGES (duty badges reflect position of assignment; e.g. HAF, Joint Staff, Recruiting Service, European Command Badge): Center duty or miscellaneous badge on the wearer's right 1/2 inch above the nametag

If authorized, a second badge will also be worn 1/2 inch above the nametag and centered and spaced 1/2 inch apart from the first badge

Missile badge is worn 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered (when wearing a duty badge) or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

Excellence-In-Competition badge is worn 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered (when wearing a duty badge) or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

Enlisted personnel center 3 1/2 inch sleeve chevron halfway between shoulder seam and elbow when bent at 90-degree angle

Airmen do not wear shoulder mark insignia

Tie tab is optional with short sleeve princess style blouse

The total number of badges worn will not exceed four. The commander's insignia does not count as one of the four badges.

Chaplain, aeronautical, space, cyberspace and missile operations badges are mandatory, others are optional.

Women are authorized to wear the men's service cap.

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ENLISTED SHORT SLEEVE BLOUSE WITH TIE TAB, SKIRT (PRINCESS CUT)

Center blue name tag on wearer's right within 1 1/2 inch above or below the first exposed button

Optional Epoxy blue name tag may be worn

Ribbons are optional. If worn, all ribbons and devices must be worn

Center ribbons on wearer's left, parallel with ground. Align bottom of the ribbons with the bottom of the name tag

Members are highly encouraged to wear their current occupational badge

Wear only midsize or regular occupational badges, do not mix sizes



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Excellence-In-Competition badge is 1 1/2 inch below the bottom of the ribbons and centered or on the wearer's right, 1/2 inch above the name tag

Center ribbons on wearer's left, parallel with ground. Align bottom of the ribbons with the bottom of the name tag

Members are highly encouraged to wear their current occupational badge

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Enlisted personnel center 3 1/2 inch sleeve chevron halfway between shoulder seam and elbow when bent at 90-degree angle

Tie tab is not mandatory with short sleeve princess style blouse
