No later than 365 days prior to separation/retirement/release from active duty, regardless of intent to reenlist or extend

Contact your Military & Family Readiness Center to schedule 18 - 24 Months Out Initial Counseling (IC) and Pre-Separation Counseling.

Initial Counseling Session - First Transition Activity

Once the Service Member (SM) completes the personal self-assessment, the TAP counselor assigns a Tier Designation and explains transition requirements. During these sessions, SMs will have the opportunity to discuss their unique post-transition plans. М
